Third Annual Mattamuskeet Decoy & Waterfowl Festival

Rules & Guidelines

These Rules & Guidelines have been established in an effort to produce a quality festival for our exhibitors and the public. This is not a mass merchandising event. The goal of HCWA is to hold a festival that represents the best of our waterfowl history, high standards and tradition.

1. Set up is required during designated times only.
2. Booths must be manned during show hours.
3. Adequate table covers are required.
4. Booths must be clean and tidy at all times.
5. Please keep displays within your designated booth area.
6. It is each vendor's responsibility to be in compliance with North Carolina State sales tax regulations.
7. Booths must not be disassembled until after 4:00PM Sunday the 21.
8. Booths can't be subleased or shared.
9. T shirts, caps or any advertising specialty products are prohibited unless previously approved.
10. Alcohol is prohibited on school grounds.
11. Products must be waterfowl and decoy related.
12. Park in designated parking areas.
13. Please unload then move your vehicle to a parking area.
14. Exhibitor releases and holds harmless from any liability or damage, injury, or loss to any person or losses from any cause whatsoever, the management, facility owners, the show director and their associates against any and all claims for damages, injury or loss arising out of his use of the space and grounds used for this show.
15. No firearms sales.

Please remember that this is a festival run by volunteers and school groups for the benefit of Mattamuskeet High School and local community groups. The \$5.00 single day pass (\$8.00 two day pass) donation is minimal and very important to cover the costs associated with the festival. Help us by ensuring that all attendees purchase a ticket at the front door.
